






THE ROSWELL INCIDENT By: Anthony Paul Wardlow

On July 2, 1947, a flying saucer supposedly crashed on the property of rancher W.W. Mac Brazel. Mac found tinfoil, rubber, and thin wooden beams scattered across a square mile of his ranch near Roswell, New Mexico and transported the debris to the sheriff in Roswell. This set off a cascading event that led to the US Army becoming involved in a mystery that is still talked about today. On July 8, 1947 the Roswell Army Air Field public information officer issued a press release, stating that a flying disc was discovered on a ranch near Roswell before the wreckage was identified as pieces of an ordinary weather balloon the next day. The story slowly was forgotten and relegated to the dustbin of history until 1978 when the National Enquirer tabloid newspaper reprinted the original article from 1947. The story entered popular culture and remains with us to this day. Roswell is the home of the International UFO Museum, featuring UFO phenomenon exhibits and The Alien Caffeine Espresso Bar. Was it aliens, a weather balloon, or some test dummies? We will never know. So, on July 2, World UFO Day, try to think what may have happened on that quiet dark New Mexico night and think of all the possibilities. 




Nelson Mandela International Day July 18, 2023

Nelson Mandela International Day celebrates the life of a remarkable man on his birthday, July 18. Mandela was devoted to serving humanity as a human rights lawyer, a prisoner of conscience, an international peacemaker, and as the first democratically elected president of a free South Africa. In 1964, Mandela was sentenced to life in prison for plotting to overthrow South Africa's apartheid regime. He spent 27 years in prison and was released in 1990 as the rein of apartheid was ending. Nelson Mandela will be remembered as a hero whose leadership and influence helped to end apartheid and bring peace and reconciliation to South Africa.

Apartheid was a governmental policy of segregation on the grounds of race with many laws regulating and restricting the rights, movement, and lives of Black people in South Africa.


